Eligibility?

- The applicant must be employed as a full-time, practicing school counselor on October 1, 2021 and have completed at least three years as a practicing school counselor.
- The applicant must hold a master's degree in School counseling and be licensed as a school counselor.
- The applicant must be a member of OSCA.

Considerations?

- Demonstrating implementation of a comprehensive, data-driven school counseling program that addresses career, personal/social and academic development.
- Demonstrating leadership and collaboration within the work setting.
- Demonstrate continual professional development.
- Maintain highest standards of personal and recognize their personal conduct is held up to public scrutiny.

Nomination Window?

- Nominations for Oregon School Counselor of the Year are being accepted through March 31, 2021.

Process?

- Nominations held through March 31, 2021.
- All Nominees are notified in April and provided an application to complete for consideration.
- Winner is announced in November, during OSCA annual conference.
